Civil society organizations play a crucial role in guiding societies toward progress and fostering democratic ideals that they face challenge of building modern, independent civil institutions capable of fulfilling their mission. However, one of the primary obstacles activists and these organizations encounter is securing sustainable funding to carry out their societal roles effectively.

CSOs have access to various funding sources to support their operations and projects, such as collecting donations, generating income through specialized programs, and receiving support from the private sector and other contributors. However, reliance on international agencies poses challenges, as these sources often diminish over time due to the resolution of the crises they were established to address, including humanitarian emergencies, poverty, unemployment, illiteracy, and human rights violations.

Recognizing this need, Public Aid Organization (PAO) and its Fundraising Department have compiled and published an annual preliminary list of funding sources available to Iraqi organizations. This marks the six consecutive years of this initiative, aimed at supporting local efforts and initiatives. The 2026 list focuses on global and international institutions. PAO remains committed to continuing this publication in the years to come, providing valuable resources to empower local organizations.

تلعب منظمات المجتمع المدني دوراً حاسماً في توجيه المجتمعات نحو التقدم وتعزيز المثل الديمقراطية التي تواجه تحدي بناء مؤسسات مدنية حديثة ومستقلة قادرة على الوفاء بمهنتها. ومع ذلك، فإن إحدى العقبات الأساسية التي يواجهها النشطاء وهذه المنظمات هي تأمين التمويل المستدام القائم بأدوارهم المجتمعية بشكل فعال.

تتمنى منظمات المجتمع المدني بالقدرة على الوصول إلى مصادر تمويل مختلفة لدعم عملياتها ومشاريعها، مثل جمع التبرعات، وتوليد الدخل من خلال برامج متخصصة، وتلقي الدعم من القطاع الخاص والمساهمين الآخرين. ومع ذلك، فإن الاعتماد على الوكالات الدولية يفرض تحديات، حيث تتضاعل هذه المصادر غالباً بمرور الوقت بسبب حل الأزمات التي أنشئت لمعالجتها، بما في ذلك حالات الطوارئ الإنسانية والفقر والبطالة والأمية وانتهاكات حقوق الإنسان.

وإدراكاً لهذه الحاجة، قامت منظمة المساعدة العامة (PAO) بجمع التبرعات التابع لها بتجميع ونشر قائمة أولية سنوية لمصادر التمويل المتاحة للمنظمات العراقية. ويمثل هذا العام سنتين متتاليتين من هذه المبادرة، التي تهدف إلى دعم الجهود والمبادرات المحلية. ترتكز قائمة 2026 على المؤسسات العالمية والدولية. وتظل منظمة PAO ملتزمة بمواصلة نشر هذا المنشور في السنوات القادمة، وتوفير موارد قيمة لتمكين المنظمات المحلية.
